Level of Financial Support after Year 1

The University Fellows Award offers fully-funded support from the Graduate College in year 1 of the nominee's studies, professional development funding in year 2, and other opportunities throughout a Fellow's time at the University of Arizona.

Colleges and programs that recruit a fellow are required to provide support for years 2-5 of the Fellow's degree program, pending academic performance and availability of funds. In the vast majority of participating colleges, support is in the form of a 0.50 FTE Graduate Assistantship each semester. The bare minimum of financial assistance is the equivalent of a 0.25 FTE Graduate Assistantship and full tuition coverage each semester. (Support can be in the form of tuition waivers, scholarships, assistantships, etc.) If a Fellow is awarded external funding, such

as an NSF Graduate Research Fellowship, the program's financial commitment can be met by the external funding source.
